# PROPOSED CHANGE OF COMPANY NAME; AND NOTICE OF EXTRAORDINARY GENERAL MEETING

#### **INTRODUCTION**

Reference is made to the announcement of the Company dated 20 December 2019. The purpose of this circular is to provide you with information in respect of the special resolution to be proposed at the EGM to seek the approval of the Shareholders in respect of the proposed Change of Company Name.

#### PROPOSED CHANGE OF COMPANY NAME

The Board proposes to change the Company's English name from "Yat Sing Holdings Limited" to "China Supply Chain Holdings Limited" and its dual foreign name in Chinese from "日成控股有限公司" to "中國供應鏈產業集團有限公司", subject to the conditions set out in the paragraph headed "Conditions of the Change of Company Name" below.

## CONDITIONS OF THE CHANGE OF COMPANY NAME

The Change of Company Name is subject to the fulfillment of the following conditions:

- (a) the passing of a special resolution by the Shareholders approving the Change of Company Name at the EGM; and
- (b) the approval of the Registrar of Companies in the Cayman Islands being obtained for the Change of Company Name.

Subject to the satisfaction of the conditions set out above, the Change of Company Name will take effect upon the date on which the Registrar of Companies in the Cayman Islands enters the new English name and the new dual foreign name in Chinese of the Company on the register of companies in place of the former English name and the former dual foreign name in Chinese and issues a certificate of incorporation on change of name.
